**ORDER GRANTING RECEIVER'S EMERGENCY MOTION TO EXPAND
RECEIVERSHIP TO INCLUDE MY GEE BO, INC.**

This CAUSE comes before the Court on the Receiver's Emergency Motion to Expand Receivership to Include My Gee Bo, Inc. (the "Motion") filed by James D. Sallah, Esq., the court-appointed receiver (the "Receiver") of JCS Enterprises Inc. d/b/a JCS Enterprises Services, Inc. and T.B.T.I, Inc. (collectively, the "Receivership Entities") on April 11, 2014. Upon review of the Motion and the entire file and being otherwise duly advised on the premises, the Court finds it appropriate to grant the Motion and to expand the Amended Receivership Order entered on April 7, 2014 (the "Amended Receivership Order") [DE19] to include My Gee Bo, Inc., a Florida corporation. Accordingly, it is


ORDERED:

1. The Motion is GRANTED.
2. The receivership is expanded to include My Gee Bo, Inc., its subsidiaries, successors, and assigns and all of its respective assets.

3. This Court's Amended Receivership Order dated April 7, 2014 is amended and expanded in all respects to include My Gee Bo, Inc. as if it were included among the original entities over which James D. Sallah, Esq. was appointed the Receiver. The Amended Receivership Order shall apply with equal force and effect to My Gee Bo, Inc. as it applies to the original Receivership Entities. The terms, orders, and provisions of the Amended Receivership Order are incorporated herein by reference as to My Gee Bo, Inc.
